
# Everything you know is wrong! ...or maybe just needs an update

- we've always been a network society; now we know it.







#### Open Net Initiative data on Internet filtering











## Outlink bundles: the view from the 'sphere'




#### Outlink bundles: large-scale link patterns










#### peak vs. time to peak





